





Higher Education in the Philippines

Higher education in the Philippines is coordinated by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED). Currently, there are 4.7 million students enrolled in almost 2000 higher education institutions (HEIs) in the country, where teaching is almost exclusively conducted in English (the co-official language of the Philippines).

In 2016, CHED emphasized internationalization: most institutions have restructured and now have an "Office of International Linkages," participate in European projects, and are beginning to develop student exchange programs. 62 bilateral agreements between France and the Philippines have been identified (in institutional cooperation, European projects, student exchanges, and research).

France is seen as an attractive destination, and both economic and demographic growth rates suggest an increase in student mobility. 629 Filipino students are currently enrolled in France.

The French Embassy to the Philippines and Micronesia carried out an internationalization project in 2024 under the French Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs funding, focused on the development of student exchanges. Under this project, a delegation of 16 partner universities in the Philippines went to the European Association for International Education conference in Toulouse in September 2024, where many contacts were made.

European Higher Education Fair (EHEF)

As in several countries, the European Higher Education Fair is coordinated by the Delegation to the European Union. It gathers nearly all European countries, and between 2,000 and 3,000 students typically attend each year.
