



Study in Europe Fair in Cambodia – Phnom Penh 2025

Important information

Thank you for your interest in participating in the Study in Europe Fair 2025, to be held in Phnom Penh, Cambodia on 12 November 2025.

We are proud to host so many European Universities in Phnom Penh.

As you are aware, a border conflict between Cambodia and Thailand escalated in late July 2025.

This message is to reassure our European partners that Phnom Penh remains safe and secure for travel and business, and the Study in Europe Fair will take place as planned.

Following the clashes at the border, there are currently no active fronts or exchanges of fire.

Daily life in Phnom Penh and the vast majority of the country is unaffected.

International flights operate normally, and visitors to Phnom Penh face no additional security risks. Siem Reap, including Angkor Wat, is fully accessible. Travel to areas close to the border provinces of Oddar Meanchey and Preah Vihear are to be avoided, however.

The EU Delegation, together with EU member state embassies in Cambodia, continues to monitor the situation closely.

In case of any substantial change, we will inform you. You may also wish to consult the travel advice issued by your national authorities.

ABC of the FAIR

Arrival

Arrival at the fair – We suggest arriving at the fair on **12th November between 7h30AM and 7h50AM** to be set for 8h00 official opening. *Please be mindful that events in Cambodia start on time, and it is recommended to arrive early.* Once you arrive at Koh Pich city hall, please enter the building and go to the registration table to have your QR scanned.

The opening ceremony will start at 8h00 sharp.

Booths

The booths are all in-door in an A/C location. The booths will be mostly used in the afternoon, when the fair is open to the public.

How does the booth look like?

2mx2mx2.5m with partition walls, one table, 2 chairs, two fluorescent lights, one waste basket, and a stable power supply with backup.



Each booth is also equipped with **one 24-inches screen** and HDMI cable (length 1.5m) to project your university videos from your laptop. If applicable, please consider bringing your own Apple connector.

We suggest you bring self-standing **pull-up banners** to decorate your booth. **Posters** can also be put on the partitioning walls. Booth setup time

The booths can be visited and set-up already on **Tuesday, 11th November afternoon** from **2:00pm** onwards. In case you wish to set-up your booth before this time, kindly inform sopheak.peou90@gmail.com and eucambodia24@gmail.com.

Booths will be grouped by country and a floor map will be shared prior to the event. The booth list will be closed by 10 October 2025. Booths will mostly be used for the open to the public session in the afternoon.

Climate

Cambodia is a sub-tropical country. **The venue is in-door and has air conditioning in all rooms – you may need a light jacket.** Business attire is recommended for the event.

e-VISA and VISA on ARRIVAL

You will need a visa to enter Cambodia. Your passport validity should be at least of 6 months.

The type of visa to be requested is Tourist visa. E-visa for Tourist (VISA T) can be obtained online in 3 business days for a cost of 36 USD. Please apply [HERE](#).

Please note that the Cambodian immigration officers might require you to print the visa before arrival. We suggest to print two copies as they might ask for one also upon exiting Cambodia.

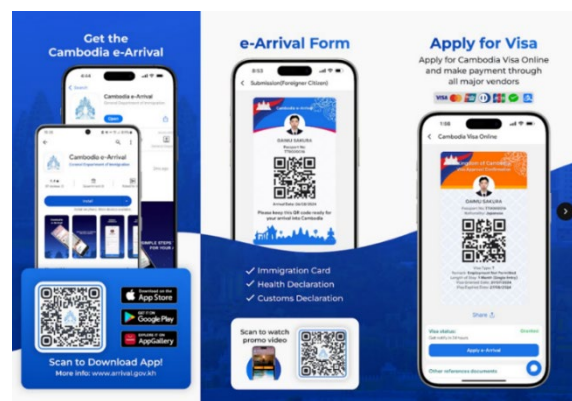
A visa on arrival can also be obtained in the airport arrivals area. There is clear signage and airport staff on hand to help you on this.

COMPULSORY e-ARRIVAL CARD (prior to arrival)

Visa and e-Arrival Card are two separate mandatory processes.

All travellers –including these already in possess of a valid visa- must submit the e-Arrival Card within 7 days prior to their arrival. This process can be done before embarking the plane and the e-arrival QR code shall be saved on the phone, to show the authorities.

1. The e-Arrival Card can be completed via:
 - a. [The official website](#)
 - b. A mobile app available on both the [Apple App Store](#) and [Google Play](#) Store.

2. Process Overview:

- a. Registration: Travelers will need to upload a photo and their passport information.
- b. Completion: Fill out the e-Arrival Card, which consolidates multiple forms into one.
- c. QR Code Generation: After submission, a QR code will be generated. This should be saved on a mobile device or printed for presentation to immigration officials.

Notes:e-Visa Option: The system also allows for reserving an e-Visa on arrival, simplifying the visa application process (but shall be done at least 3 days in advance).

It is essential to complete the e-Arrival Card and get the QR code even if you already have a valid visa.

Welcome to Phnom Penh Step by Step

Cambodia

Cambodia has the fourth largest youth population in the South-East Asia region (UNDESA, 2020).

Its economy has grown at an average rate of 7.6% p.a. between 1995 and 2019, making it one of the fastest-growing economies in the world. After reaching lower middle-income status in 2015, its sights are set on becoming an upper middle-income economy by 2030 and a higher-income economy by 2050 (World Bank, April 2024)

Phnom Penh, the Cambodian capital, is connected via direct flight to main cities in Asia, such as Bangkok, Hanoi, Ho Chi Min, Singapore, Taipei, Beijing, New Delhi, Manila and Jakarta. Direct flights from/to Phnom Penh [HERE](#).

Please note that Cambodia just opened a new international airport south of Phnom Penh. Distance: approximately 25km to the city centre. The international IATA airport code is KTI. The transportation takes at least one hour to the city-depending to traffic.

Sim Card (With Internet Data)

Phone and internet connections are quite good and cheap in Cambodia. At Phnom Penh International Airport, you will find several phone company kiosks such as SMART, Cellcard and Metfone outside the arrival terminal. To purchase a SIM, you are required to present your passport. The usual cost of a sim card should around the \$8 USD range.

Transfer To Your Hotel and Around the City

We suggest you download and create a profile on the Singapore-based [Grab App](#). Grab is like Uber in its function. Payment can be done in cash or via the uploaded credit card.

Please note that the Grab pick-up area will require you to walk towards the road outside the arrival hall (a short 1-minute walk) - you will see a large "Grab" sign.

There are taxi kiosks in the arrival's terminal at the luggage claim. These are perfect for reliable taxi services. These taxis are outside the arrivals area and require no pick-up area

walking. Grab can be cheaper than this service, although convenience is the over-riding factor for this type of service.

Currencies

The Cambodian Riel is the national currency, but the US dollar is widely accepted and used in most transactions: 4,200 Riels= 1 USD. US dollars – especially in small denomination notes - are widely accepted, provided they are in good conditions (no marks, writing or wrinkled). ATM machines are widely available around town and offer two currencies (local Riel and US Dollar notes).

ACCOMMODATION

Phnom Penh has several hotels, available on Booking and other major platforms. The EU Delegation has agreed a **corporate rate** with several convenient accommodations, listed below.

WHAT to do in Phnom Penh

Phnom Penh is a vibrant city with plenty of restaurants and nice spots. Phnom Penh is easy to discover as tuktuk and taxis are widely available and at a reasonable price. The main tourist attractions are the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda, the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum, Choeung Ek Genocidal Centre, the National Museum and the Sosoro Museum.

November marks the end of the rainy season but you may experience some rain.

And beyond

Siem Reap, home of Angkor Wat is the main touristic destination in Cambodia. It can be reached from Phnom Penh by plane (50 min) or by road (4-5 hours) via private taxis or buses. You can buy a pass to visit the famous temples here: <https://www.angkorenterprise.gov.kh/>
